

At Hillsborough Christian Academy, we place an emphasis on rigorous academics. We also realize that some students need more assistance in understanding and mastering concepts. With that in mind, we have developed the following program to assist our students who need extra support.

### Program Information:

Student Academic Services options are available to meet the additional needs of students beyond the classroom environment. These services are provided by an ACSI certified faculty member with a minimum of a bachelor's degree. These services are designed in collaboration with the student's classroom teacher and school administration and are offered in 30-60 minute sessions 1-3 times per week.

All program options include on-going communication from the classroom teacher. Students enrolled in Level 1-3 of the program will also receive weekly (Level 3) or Monthly (Level 1-2) communication from the Academic Coach.

### Program Enrollment:

HCA students may be enrolled in our Student Academic Services if one of the following requirements are met:

1. Student has an IEP issued within the last two years that identifies reading or mathematics as an area of need.
2. Student has a diagnosis provided by a child psychologist which identifies reading or mathematics as an area of learning difficulty.
3. Student is referred to HCA Administration by their classroom teacher for academic struggles in reading or mathematics.

Following the initial referral to the program, a member of the HCA administrative team will reach out to offer program enrollment options. An Academic Support Plan must be in place for any student receiving classroom level or Standardized Testing Accommodations.
